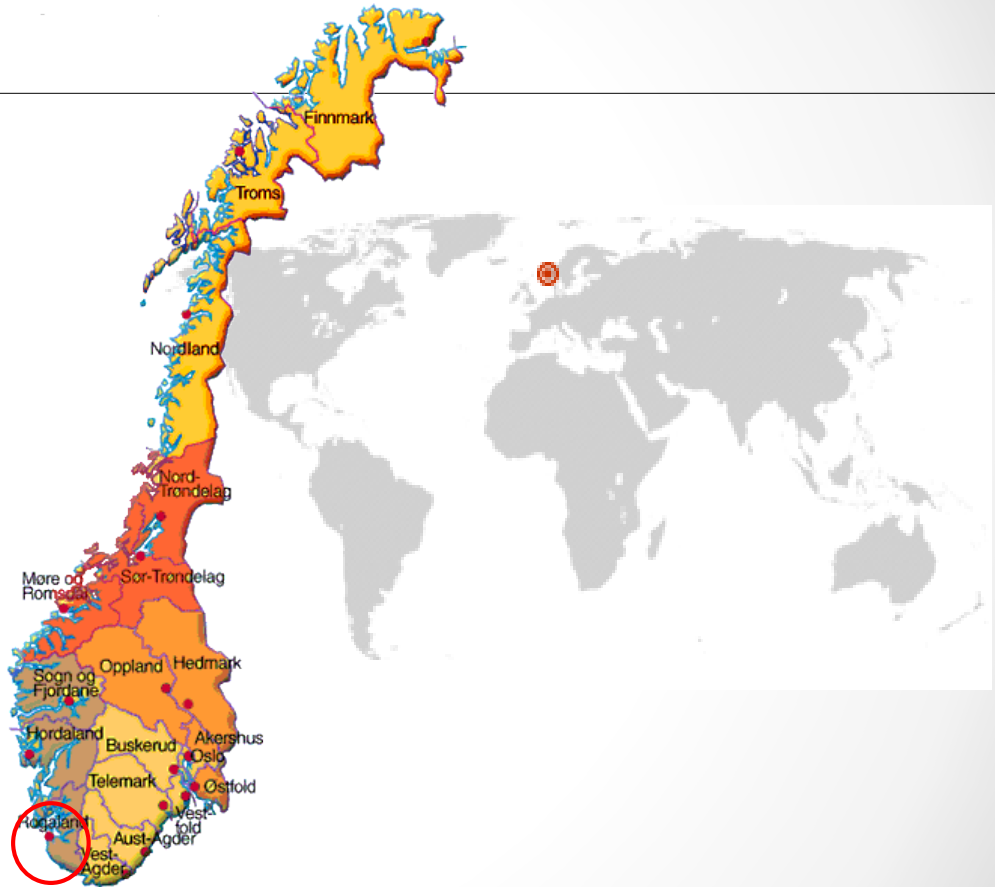

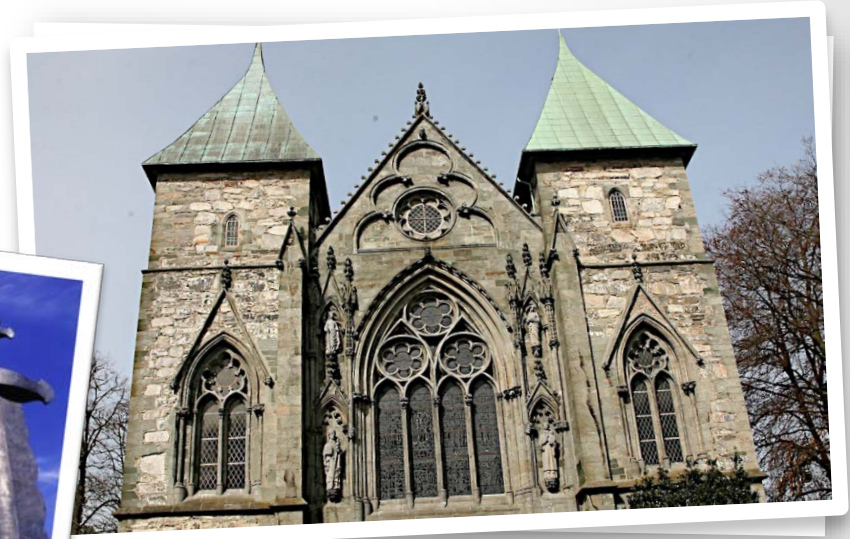

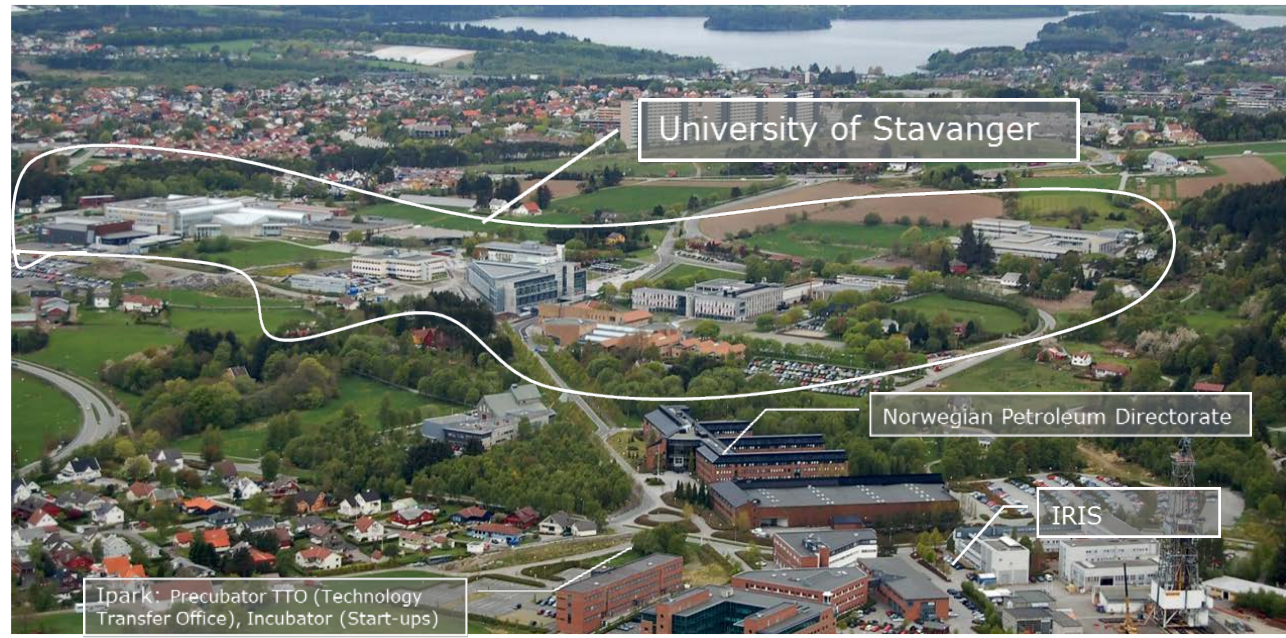

Academic year

- 2 semesters:
 - Autumn (August - December)
 - Spring (January - June)
- Courses are measured in ECTS credits according to the European Credit Transfer System standard. The full-time workload for one academic year is 60 ECTS credits.
- Exams at the end of each semester
- Graded scale from A (highest) to F (lowest), with E as the minimum pass grade
